

NORTHBOUND SHIPMENTS

The inbond shipments originated in Mexico and having the U.S. as its final destination are known as Northbound Shipments.

The customs agency at Nuevo Laredo, Tamaulipas, Mexico is the crossing point of all northbound shipments we handle.

- ①▶ The exporting client will assign a Mexican and American Customs Broker who will each be responsible for their respective required Import and Export process.
- ②▶ Once the paperwork from the Mexican broker is ready, the container will be loaded on a railway platform and transported by KCSM to Mexico's customs authorities in Nuevo Laredo, Tamps.
- ③▶ When the units arrive to KCSM's railway station in Nuevo Laredo, TCS will close the inbond process with Mexican customs officials.
- ④▶ Once the inbond process is closed, KCSM will interchange convoys with KCS who will then be responsible of transporting the shipments to Serrano Yard, its intermodal facility in Laredo, Texas.
- ⑤▶ Inside Serrano Yard, TCS will prepare the shipments for arrival to their final destination.
